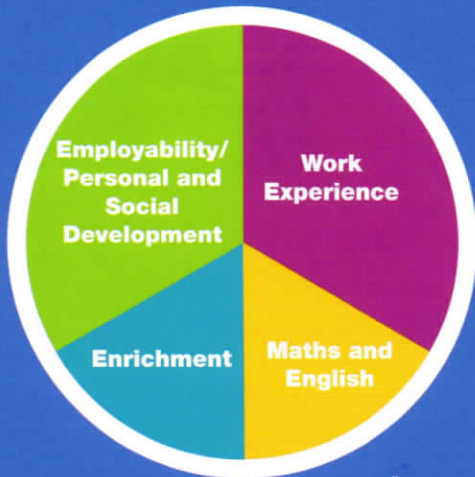

**Up to £40 bursary, including travel expenses, per week.**

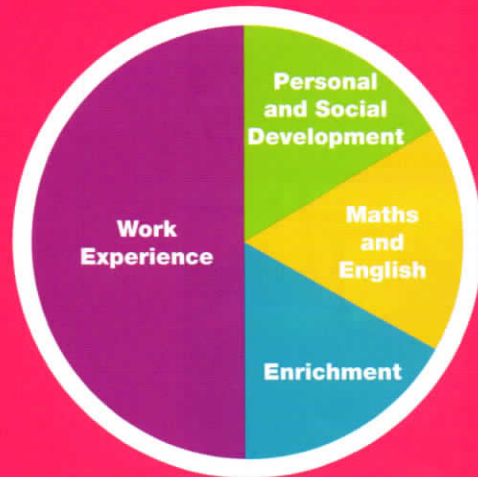

## Dominic Hanratty

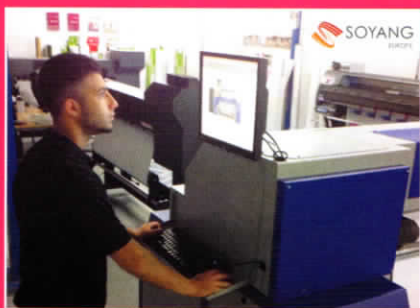
- Achieved English and maths Functional Skills
